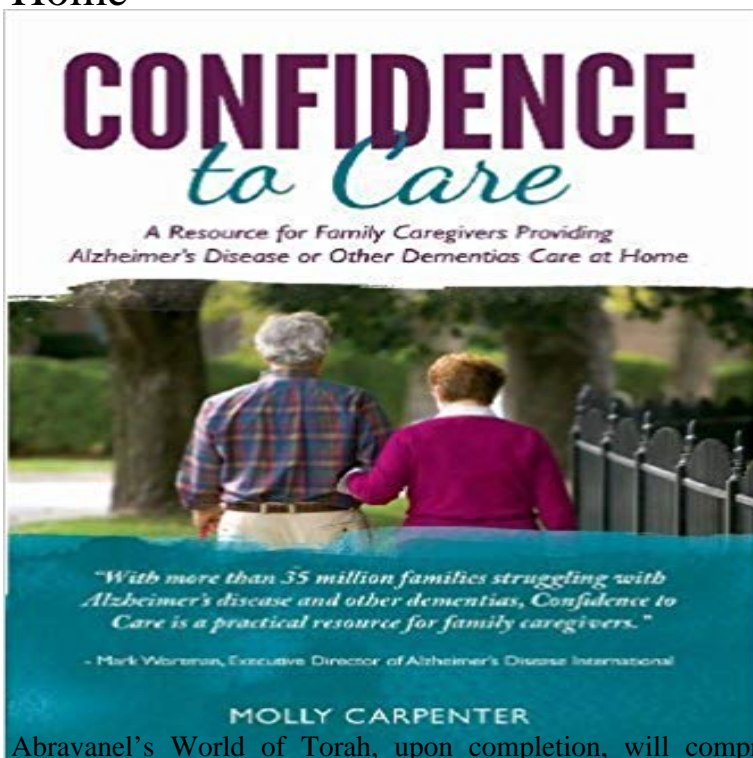


Confidence to Care [Canadian Edition]: A Resource for Family Caregivers Providing Alzheimers Disease or Other Dementias Care at Home
