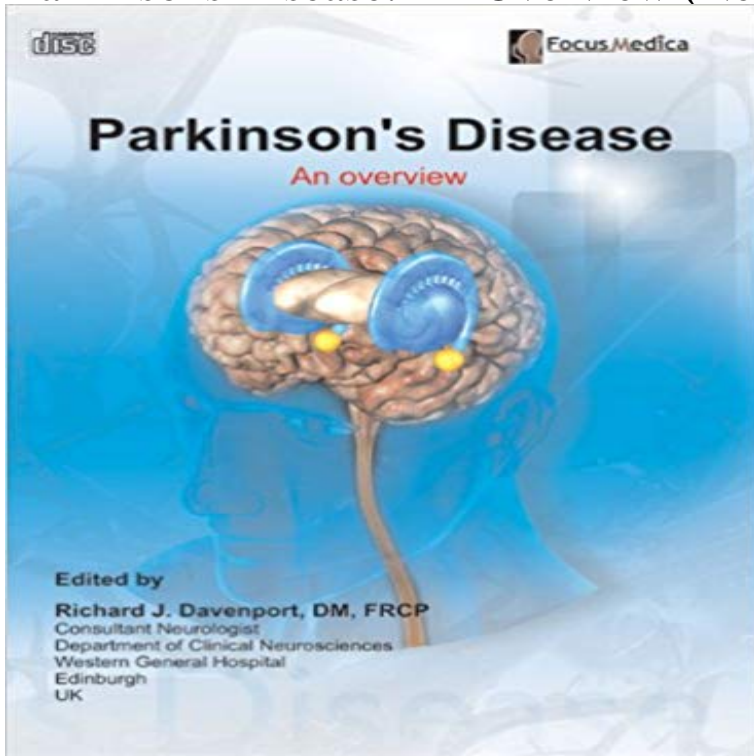


Parkinsons Disease: An Overview (Neurology)
