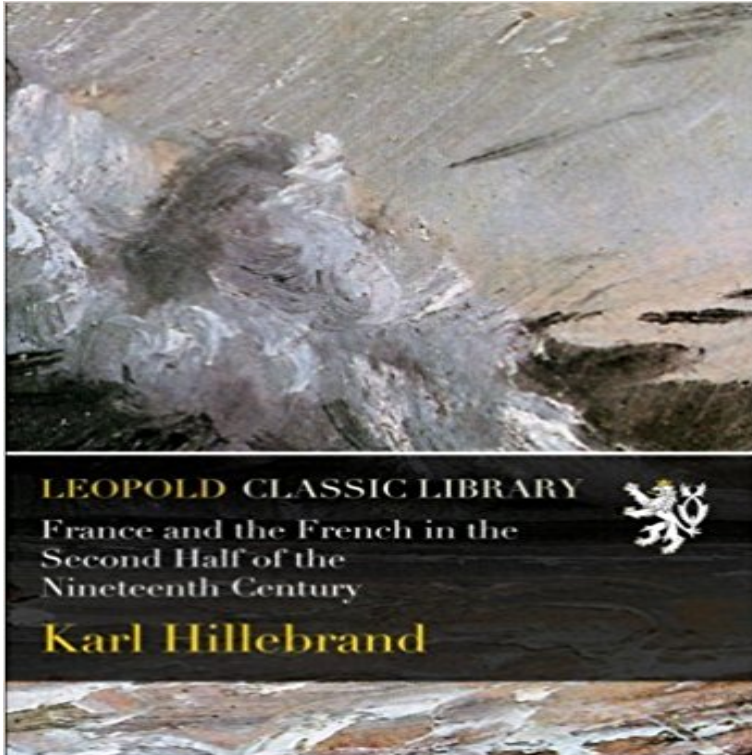


## France and the French in the Second Half of the Nineteenth Century
