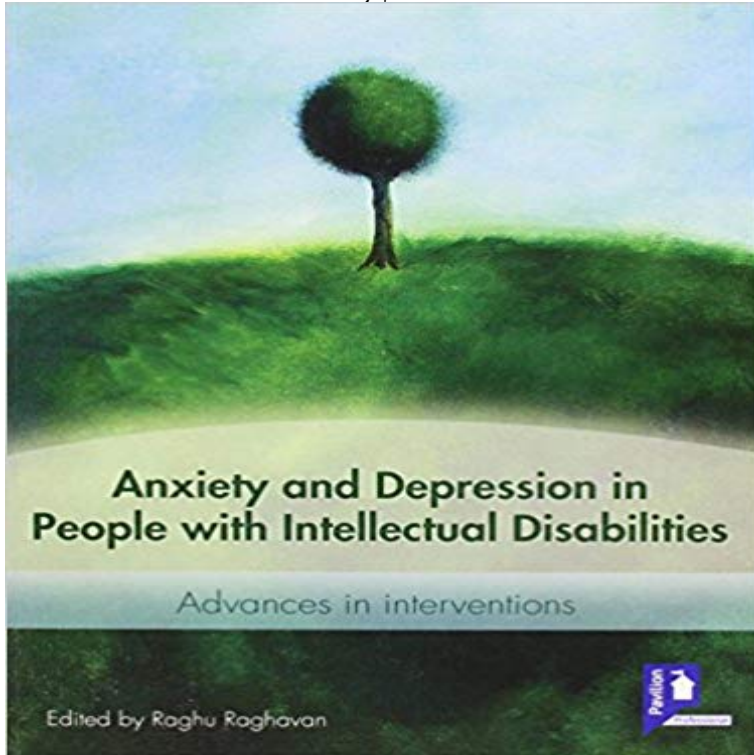


# Anxiety and Depression in People with Learning Disabilities: Intervention strategies
