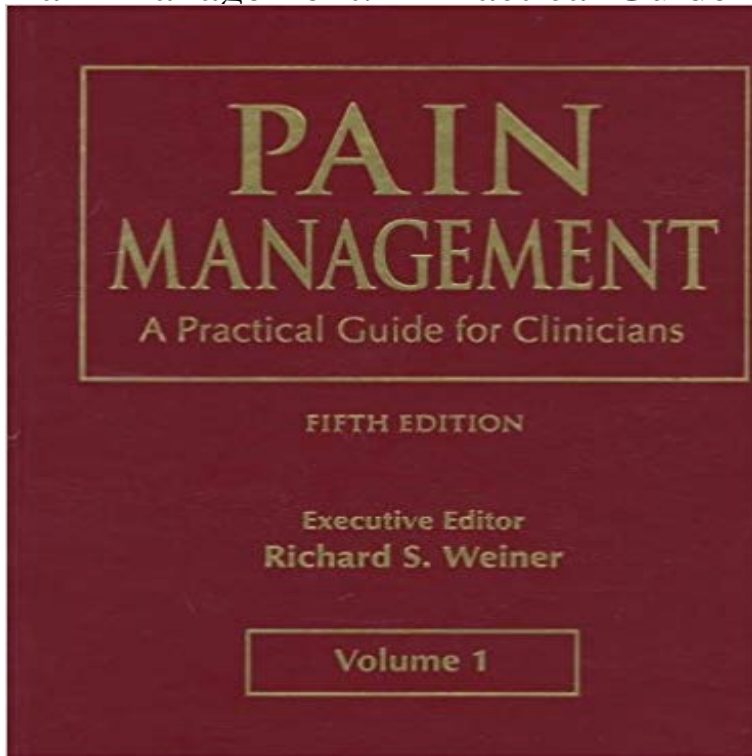


Pain Management: A Practical Guide for Clinicians (Two-Volume Set)
